The following will be the initial apparatus responses when responding to an incident.

City Calls

Residential & Commercial automatic alarms: Engine 1515, Tower 1521, Engine 1511, Rescue 1531, Medic

Residential & Commercial fires: Engine 1515, Engine 1511, Tower 1521, Rescue 1531, (2) Medic units

Washdowns, dumpsters: Engine 1515

Vehicle fire: Engine 1515, Rescue 1531, Medic

Brush fire: Brush 1571, 1572, 1573, Engine 1515, Medic

Accident: Medic, Engine 1515, Rescue 1531

Accident on I-65: Medic, Engine 1515, Rescue 1531, (2nd Medic to stand by at Mobil)

Gas leak or gas odor: Engine 1515, Rescue 1531, Medic

CO with reported sick people: Engine 1515, Rescue 1531, Medic

CO with no reported sickness: Medic (on duty crew)

Center Township

All calls will be handled the same as above except that Engine 1514 will respond in place of Engine 1515. Tanker 1541 will respond for water supply. Engine 1511 will respond as second engine.

Accident calls will be Medic, Rescue 1531, and Engine 1514.
